*Use simple massage as lyrics indicate. Touch is a baby's first language, and in addition to aiding in bonding it reassures and builds security for babies. Lay your baby on a blanket in front of you as you sing and do the motions and massage.*

*First two lines of each verse, arms bent at sides, moving in circles like train wheels. Move in rhythm to the song. Last line, reach up with one fist to pull the train whistle as you sing (woo woo)*

*Use as a movement song instead. Choose one child to be the engine, another to be the caboose, and the rest of the children can be the cars. Give each of the children who are the cars a sticky dot, so they will*

*know what color car they are. Have the engine child start moving around the room as you sing. Other children join the train as you add verses singing different colors. As you sing each verse have the children with the sung color get up and join the train as they wind around the room.*
